(Bukhara)-Turkmenabat-Ashgabat-Dashoguz-(Khiva)

3 days / 2 nights

Day 1: Farap - Turkmenabat

09:00-10:00: Meet the tourists at Farap border (close to Bukhara)

Transfer to Turkmenabat train station

Optional: Time on your own to explore Turkmenabat

17:22: Depart on [night train #96](#) to Ashgabat (*time subject to change!*)

Day 2: Ashgabat

06:05: Arrive in Ashgabat (*time subject to change!*)

Explore Ashgabat on your own

- Taxis and buses are cheap
- Lots to do and see: Russian Bazaar, Turkmenbashi Mosque, The world's largest indoor Ferris wheel (Alem), Lenin Statue and much more!
- Optional: Ashgabat city tour (*free of charge*)

20:30: Depart on [night train #93](#) to Dashoguz (*time subject to change!*)

Day 3: Dashoguz

08:44: Arrive in Dashoguz (*time subject to change!*)

Optional add-ons: (*not included!*)

- Dashoguz city tour
- Tour of Ancient Koneurgench

Transfer to Dashoguz border (close to Khiva)

Exit to Uzbekistan

The tour package includes

1. Visa Fee (\$55-175 depending on nationality)

To prepare a Letter of Invitation, we need you to fill out a digital form. This form contains questions about you, your job, your family, previous visits, and your passport.

Once you have filled out this form, it takes about three weeks to issue the Letter of Invitation. With the Letter of Invitation, you can show up at the border and get your visa on arrival without the need to visit an embassy or consulate. The visa on arrival costs about \$55-85, but this depends on your nationality. For a few select nationalities, (e.g. Russians) a visa on arrival costs \$150.

If you prefer to save some money, you can get your visa at an embassy or consulate, which costs about \$35 for adults and \$17.50 for children. However, this price also depends on your nationality and requires a bit more paperwork.
